

Official Statement

The Brazilian Association of Zebu Breeders (ABCZ), organizer of ExpoZebu - International Zebu Cattle Exhibition, sensitive to the current situation surrounding the coronavirus issue, with the emergency decree of the Government of Minas Gerais, the Municipal Government of Uberaba and following the guidance of the Federal Government, through the Ministry of Health, decided to postpone the 86th edition of the fair, which would be held between April 25th and May 3rd in Uberaba (MG).

The decision, unanimous among all members of the board, was communicated by the president of ABCZ, Rivaldo Machado Borges Júnior, to the mayor of Uberaba, Paulo Piau, this Tuesday morning (17th) at a meeting, scheduled by ABCZ itself, at the headquarters of the Association.

ABCZ deeply regrets the fact, but understands that the decision highlights the responsibility that has always guided its centenary trajectory, acting in line with the government and strictly following its determinations. In addition, at this moment, 40 days from the event, we believe that the measure will guarantee more security and tranquility to the public, to the exhibitors and sponsors of the event, who believe and represent the success of our ExpoZebu.

The new dates for the 86th ExpoZebu will be announced as soon as the future scenario is established. ABCZ continues to work in a conscious, responsible and determined manner, for the growth of our country and the promotion of our livestock.
